...which creates an objectively hostile school environment, defined as *any one or more* of the following...

Student's reasonable fear of harm to self or property

Substantially detrimental effect on the student's...

...physical or mental health.

...ability to perform academically.

...ability to participate in/benefit from the school's services, activities, or privileges.
