



6th Grade Choir

<u>Description:</u> 6th grade chorus is an elective for all students. No audition is required. This class emphasizes healthy singing technique and basic music literacy. 6th grade chorus performs a wide variety of choral repertoire in the winter and spring. Additional performance opportunities may be available. The group meets on either blue or white days (approximately 2-3 times per week) opposite band or guided study.
