



Sixth Grade General Music

Description: General Music is an exploratory class that meets every day for 7 weeks. Every 6th and 7th grade student has General Music for a quintile.

In 6th grade, students learn how to play piano, read both treble and bass clef note names, note/rest values to help reading rhythms, other music symbols, and finally intervals. Much of this learning transfers into the choral and instrumental setting for students.
