

Seventh Grade General Music

Description: General Music is an exploratory class that meets every day for 7 weeks. Every 6th and 7th grade student has General Music for a quintile.

In 7th grade, students learn the guitar parts, basic chords and strumming patterns. The final goal is for students to be able to play beginner level music on guitar independently. In addition, students continue to work on reading rhythms and notes.
