Description:

Journalism 2, 3, 4: Journalism II is designed to give the student the opportunity to apply the skills gained in Journalism I. Students in Journalism II are responsible for writing, editing, and publishing the school newspaper. Students are responsible for planning each issues, writing and typing the copy, editing and proofing the stories, shooting the photos, and designing the layouts.

Yearbook: Yearbook is an exciting, challenging and fun class. Throughout the class students will learn about page layout and design, publishing, journalism, photography, and business/sales skills. Being member of the staff is an awesome responsibility, but by the end of the year, you have produced a book that is valued by students, faculty and community.
