



Course Title: **UHS Symphonic Band**

Description: This course is a performance-based class, giving approximately 15-20 performances each school year. Band meets every day. Two substantial units of study will take place throughout the year: 1. Marching band 2. Concert band. During quarter one, all students enrolled in band will study marching band. During quarter two, three, and four, all students will be placed by ability in symphonic band (for intermediate students), the Wind Ensemble (for proficient students), or Wind Symphony (for advanced students). All groups will perform at many concerts within the school district and contests around the state.
