Hours of Operation

Adventuretime Drop off and Pick up hours are as follows:



Mornings:

Drop-off will take place from 6:30-8:15 AM (9:15 on Late Starts) at all buildings. After the drop-off times students will be unable to attend Adventuretime in the mornings. Parents will need to follow building specific guidelines for drop-off.

Afternoons:

Pick-Up will begin at 4:00 PM at all buildings. We will not have a greeter at the doors to let parents in before that. If you need to pick-up before then, please plan on following school specific parent pick-up guidelines for that day.

Information about dropping off/ picking up your students

- Parents/guardians will be required to walk students into the facility to sign their student in/out. Please be sure to provide a photo identification upon request as we may have employees working up front who are not familiar with all parents/guardians/authorized pickups.
- Please be aware that only students and staff will be permitted past the sign in/out table.

Required Documents

Medication:

All students who need medication disbursed by a trained Adventuretime employee will need:

- · Complete and turn in an updated Medication Permission Form.
- All medications need to be current (not expired).
- Medication provided in its originally prescribed container.
- An extra label container provided for medication needed on field trips.
- Only prescribed medications are allowed to be given at Adventuretime.
